Peripheral Disturbance is a temporary art installation created by students in the Light Space Art elective at Parsons School of Design.

This course, emerging out of the MFA Lighting Design program, investigates the relationship between light, material and spatial context as provocation to trigger targeted perceptual responses. An undulating framework wrapped with monofilament line disrupts the normal visual connection between interior and exterior as passersby move along this building edge. The public opening for Peripheral Disturbance coincided with the Light for Ambient Communication public talk given by Tapio Rosenius on November 7, 2018.





The Light Space and Art Elective includes students from many multiple disciplines and schools across Parsons.





Here students explore the phenomenal relationship between light and material and the effect on human perception. Experiments are conducted empirically through physical constructs so that the students experience first-hand the perceptual dynamics at play.



Many of the spatial, theoretical and material experiments examined early in the semester coalesced in the final installation. Response to the unique attributes of the site, light and material relationships and the conceptual intent were considered in relation to the physical design of the work. Thus, fabrication, prototyping and construction of intervention were significant pedagogical foci in the class.



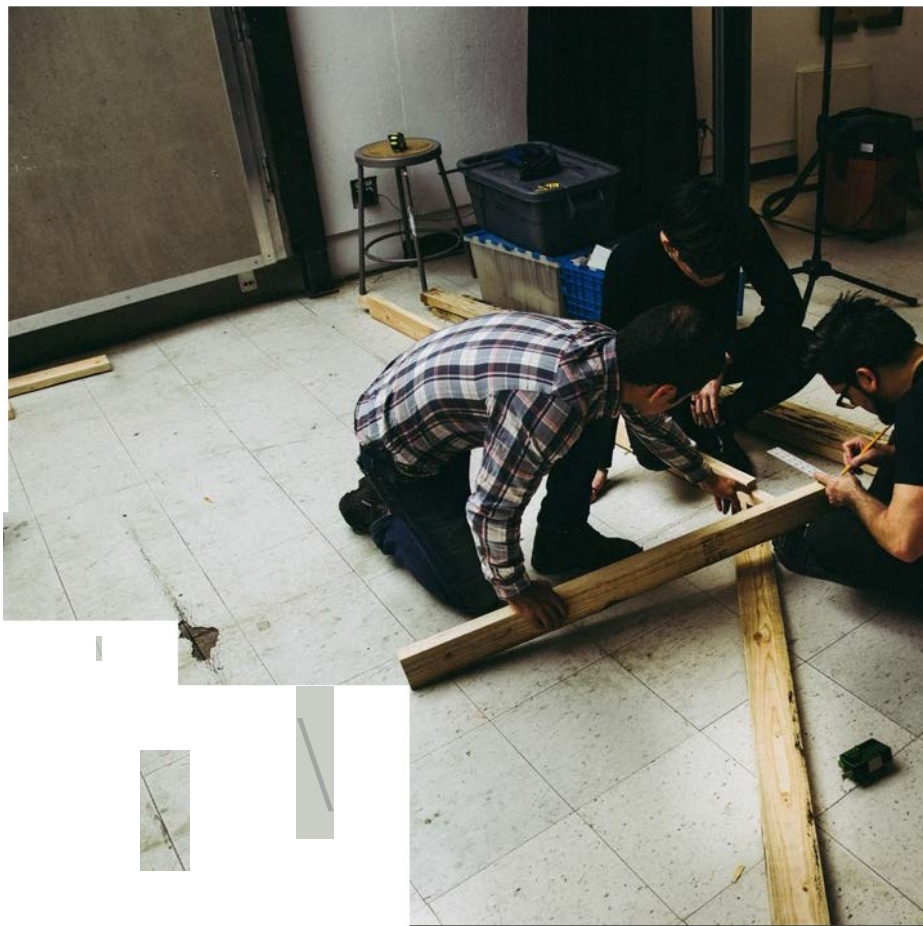








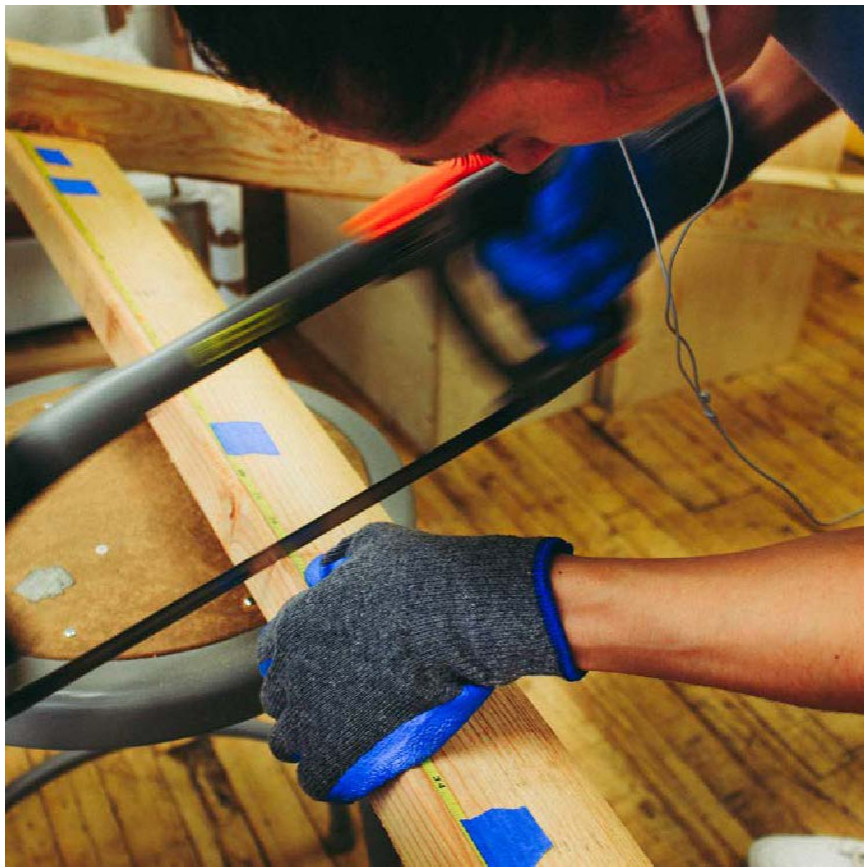










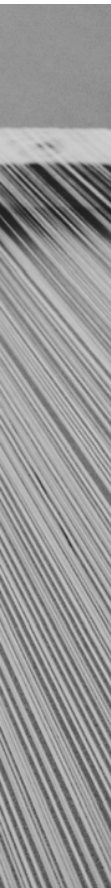
